Two partners with different native languages learn from each other. Tandem stands for stimulating language learning and cultural exchange.

What are the advantages of tandem?

- You are flexible regarding time and place for learning
- You choose learning goals and methods according to your needs and interests
- You acquire language skills in an authentic context and learn more about another culture

What should I do once I've found a tandem partner?

Contact your tandem partner. At your first meeting, you both agree on your learning goals and methods, and follow these simple rules while you learn together:

- Meet up frequently, at least two hours a week.
- Take turns in teaching and learning.
- Devote an equal amount of time to each language.
- Practice both languages separately and do not mix them.
- Stick to agreements and communicate with our tandem partner in case you cannot attend a meeting.
